

# **Club Structure and Roles**

## **Background**

The Land Rover Series One Club was formed by three enthusiasts in 1979 and has grown to be the largest Land Rover Club in the World with over 2500 members worldwide.

The Club is registered as a Limited Company in the UK and recently, due the size and turnover of the Club, has become VAT (Value Added Tax) registered.

## **Committee**

The Club Committee comprises a maximum of ten elected members who are elected at the Club's AGM and stand for a period of 12 months.

Nomination forms for committee posts are published in Legend prior to the AGM.

In addition to the elected committee members there are two 'ex-officio' posts which are voted for separately at the AGM. These are 'Club Secretary' and 'Treasurer'.

The committee can, should there be a specific reason to do so, 'co-opt' additional people onto the committee until the end of club year.

The committee meet approximately every three months and all Club Officers and Area Representatives have a standing invitation to attend should they wish to do so.

Committee members do not necessarily have to take on any specific role but, generally speaking, committee members volunteer to be responsible for one (or more) aspect(s) of Club Administration.

## **Appointed Club Officers**

These are club members who are not necessarily members of the Committee but have volunteered to take on specific responsibilities and this has been approved by the committee (examples are the Magazine Editor and Technical Officers)

## **Area Representatives**

These are Club members who have volunteered to act as representatives of the club for a geographical area and have been approved by the committee. They are, as the name suggests, the representatives of the Club in a local area and provide support and a contact point for members within their area plus a vital communication channel between members and the committee.
